 - start review - 03/03/08

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Review Highlights

- FSAR “incorporate by reference” ESBWR DCD Rev. 4
- FSAR & Environmental Report “incorporate by reference” ESP
- First S-COL for ESBWR design centered working group – sections standardized with R-COL (North Anna) & site-specific sections
- “Exemptions” & “Departures” & “Variances”
- Acceptance Review (AR) process
 - analogous to other S-COL acceptance reviews (i.e., Lee, Harris)
 - NRO-REG 100, Revision Draft 01, For Use and Comment (1/07/08)
 - Attachment G, Guide for SCOL referencing design certification
 - PM assignments similar to ESBWR DCD

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Review Highlights (continued)

- SCOL review concurrent with ESBWR DC review & RCOL review
 - DC is on-going detailed review of application docketed 12/2005
 - DC technical issues remain in DC review unless a COL action item
- Acceptance Review for SCOL – “complete & technically sufficient”
 - confirm standard sections match RCOL sections
 - modify application review schedule, as appropriate (P1, P2)
 - DC technical issues remain in DC – not AR issue
 - RCOL technical issues remain in RCOL, for standard sections – not an SCOL AR issue
- SCOL detailed review schedule dependent on RCOL completion (which is dependent on DC completion – can’t issue COL prior to certification)
