SUBJECT: SUMMARY OF FEBRUARY 21, 2008, PUBLIC MEETING REGARDING
THE GRAND GULF COMBINED LICENSE APPLICATION

On February 21, 2008, the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff held a Category 1 public meeting at the City Hall in Port Gibson, Mississippi. The purpose of the meeting was to inform the public of the NRC review process for the Grand Gulf Unit 3 Combined License (COL) application that Entergy planned to submit on February 27, 2008. The meeting agenda is provided as Enclosure 1 and the NRC presentation slides are provided as Enclosure 2.

This meeting summary and the presentation materials distributed at the meeting are available through the Agencywide Documents Access and Management System (ADAMS) as a package at Accession Number ML080780045. ADAMS is the system that provides text and image files of NRC's public documents. By letter dated August 9, 2007, NuStart Energy, in response to the NRC's Regulatory Information Summary 2007-08, informed the NRC that it, in conjunction with Entergy, identified as the applicant, intended to submit a COL application for Grand Gulf Unit 3 no later than February, 2008. Consistent with that letter, Entergy provided a verbal confirmation of their intent to submit the application by February 27, 2008. Based on the information provided by Entergy, the NRC scheduled a public outreach meeting in Port Gibson, Mississippi, to discuss the COL application review process and to provide information to the public on when and how it may participate in this review process.

Staff from the Office of New Reactors provided meeting opening remarks, an overview of the NRC organization and mission, and an overview of the process for review of the Grand Gulf COL application. NRC staff presented information on various elements of the review process which included the safety review, the environmental review process, the hearing process, and the post-licensing construction inspection process. NRC staff identified when and how the public may participate in the review process. In addition, the NRC provided a very high level summary of what it expected to be included in the Grand Gulf Unit 3 COL application: reference of the economic simplified boiling water reactor (ESBWR) design that is currently under review by the NRC; and reference of the Early Site Permit (ESP) issued by the NRC for the existing Grand Gulf site on April 5, 2007 (ML070780457). The NRC staff indicated that should the Grand Gulf Unit 3 COL application successfully pass the acceptance review, it could be officially docketed as an application for review. In addition, the NRC staff indicated that it could not issue a combined license for Grand Gulf Unit 3 without first certifying that the ESBWR design, which is currently under review, meets NRC regulations.
