SUBJECT: SUMMARY OF PUBLIC SCOPING MEETINGS TO SUPPORT REVIEW
OF THE SOUTH TEXAS PLANT COMBINED LICENSE APPLICATION
(TAC NO. MD6691)

The U.S. Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff conducted two environmental scoping meetings on February 5, 2008 to support the review of the South Texas Plant combined license application submitted by South Texas Plant Nuclear Operating Company (STPNOC). The first public meeting was conducted in the afternoon of Tuesday February 5, 2008 and the second was conducted in the evening, at the Bay City Civic Center, in Bay City, Texas. Approximately 250 people attended the afternoon meeting and 160 people attended the evening meeting, including representatives of the NRC staff, Pacific Northwest National Laboratory, STP, state and local governments, the nuclear industry, members of the public and the local news media. The NRC staff hosted an informal "open house" for one hour prior to the meetings and used displays and provided brochures to answer questions about the proposed COL application. Public comments and questions were mainly focused on the combined license application, environmental justice, alternative energy sources and radiological effluent releases. In addition, the NRC staff gave the public demonstrations on the NRC website. The list of attendees is provided in Enclosure 1. Enclosure 2 provides the agenda. Enclosures 3 and 4 contain the official corrected transcripts for the afternoon and evening public meetings. Enclosure 5 is the slides used in the NRC's presentation.
