
Combined License (COL)

- Authorization from the NRC to construct and operate a nuclear power plant at a specific site, with conditions, and in accordance with applicable laws and regulations
- Entergy submitted an application for a combined license for Grand Gulf Nuclear Station, Unit 3 on February 27, 2008

Current Reviews: Grand Gulf COL Application

- Economic Simplified Boiling Water Reactor (ESBWR) certified design rulemaking
- Site-specific safety review of the ESBWR design as located at Grand Gulf site
- Environmental impacts of Unit 3 at Grand Gulf site

Safety Review Process

- Design of facility
- Site suitability (safety)
- Quality assurance
- Physical security (coordinated with Dept. of Homeland Security)
- Emergency preparedness (with Federal Emergency Management Agency - FEMA)
- Operator training

National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA)


- NEPA requires Federal agencies to use a systematic approach to consider environmental impacts
- An Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) is required for issuing a combined license (COL)



Grand Gulf Unit 3 Environmental Review

- Prepare Supplemental EIS (SEIS) for the Grand Gulf, Unit 3 COL application
- ❖ Supplemental EIS Scope
 - ❖Tier off Final EIS for Grand Gulf ESP EIS issued April 2006
 - Issues not resolved during ESP review will be evaluated
 - NRC will look at resolved issues to see if there is new and significant information that would affect the previous analyses
