The NRC's Comprehensive Records Disposition Schedule, approved by NARA, provides that reactor licensing documents are retained by the NRC and not transferred to NARA until 20 years after termination of the license, following decommissioning. The files that must be retained include "individual applicant case files, identified by assigned docket numbers, copies of all documents received or generated in review, evaluation and authorization stages of the licensing process." This would encompass the Safety Evaluation supporting operation of the GE test reactor. Therefore, the NRC is already required to retain the type of records covered by your petition for rulemaking.
