

4.0 Administrative Departures

Table 4.0-1 lists the administrative departures identified in the development of the COLA.

Administrative departures are defined as minor corrections such as editorial or administrative errors in the reference ABWR DCD, i.e. misspelling, incorrect references, table headings, etc. Administrative departures do not affect the presentation of any design discussion or qualification of design margin. These have been screened using an evaluation methodology derived from 10 CFR 52 Appendix A Section VIII.B.5 and do not require prior NRC approval under Section VIII.B.5 of the design certification rule because they do not impact:

- Any design function.
- Method of performing or controlling a design function.
- An evaluation for demonstrating that the intended design function will be accomplished.
