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Construction Assessment Program

- Staff developed and issued construction assessment program (IMC 2505) using stakeholder input
- IMC 2505 revision to be issued by November 30
- Program will be implemented soon at Vogtle
- Uses traditional enforcement for finding significance determination
 - Minor criteria defined in MC 0613 and Enforcement Policy
 - Violation Severity Level examples provided in Enforcement Policy Supplements
- Interim approach to safety culture
- Construction Response Table dictates NRC response to licensee performance

Next Steps For Construction Assessment Program

- Commission direction to develop assessment program options for consideration
- Staff developed options with stakeholder input
- NEI CIAP proposal received
- Information SECY Paper submitted detailing next steps
- Options to be provided by November 2010
