Purpose:

To inquire about UR-Energy's proposed ISL facility at Lost Creek; what is the status of the Plan of Operation, if any; the status of current drilling/exploration; and to give the Rawlins Field Office an update on the draft MOU between the NRC and the BLM.

Discussion:

- BLM plans to meet with UR-Energy on Jan 28th
- BLM plans to conduct an inspection of the Lost Creek Site on Jan 22nd
- BLM believes that UR-Energy is looking to have some of their bond \$\$ released at this
 meeting
- BLM is concerned about bonding for these sites (BLM requires the cost of reclamation plus 19 percent)
- BLM and WYDEQ are co-signatories of bonds
- A bond is not released until it id okayed by the Sec'y of the Interior (out of DC)
- BLM does not want the site fenced (primarily for wild horses)
- FWS is concerned about the waste water ponds will require netting be placed over them
- Mud pits are also a concern
- While BLM has the final decision on water issues, hydrology issues are handled by Steve Engle of the WYDEQ in Chevenne
- BLM believes that in addition to the BLM being a signatory to the MOU for ISLs, the State also needs to be – including the DEQ, G&F, State Engineer, and WYDOT

Action Items:

- NRC to keep BLM Field Offices up to date on status of MOU
- BLM to send Environet a copy of the Land Status Map for Wyoming
