During the 583th meeting of the Advisory Committee on Reactor Safeguards (the Committee) held on May 12, 2011, the Committee completed its review of the license renewal application for Salem Nuclear Generating Station, Units 1 and 2, and the associated final safety evaluation report prepared by the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC). In the Committee's final report, dated May 25, 2011, the Committee recommended renewal of the operating licenses for Salem Nuclear Generating Station, Units 1 and 2. The NRC staff appreciates the Committee's thorough review of the plant's license renewal application and the associated final safety evaluation report. In particular, the Committee's review of aging management issues for buried piping and spent fuel pool leakage was particularly helpful as the NRC staff finalized its evaluation.

The NRC staff recognizes the Committee's commitment to safety and appreciates its continued support of the license renewal process.
