- Accomplishments Since Previous Workshop
 - Issued Powertech license and Final SEIS
 - Issued Strata license and Final SEIS
 - Crow Butte License renewal almost complete
 - Approval for operations Lost Creek ISR
 - Approval for operations Uranerz Nichols Ranch
- Current Activities
 - Reviewing 7 licensing actions
 - 3 expansions, 1 new license, and 3 license renewals
- Future Activities
 - Workload increasing operating sites
 - Two major hearings underway and two coming in late FY14
 - FY15


Priorities

- License renewals, Section 106 Programmatic Agreement activities same priority as licensed site actions


Historic Application Receipt Rates





Projections for Workload Scenarios - 2013






Applications in House includes items being worked on and anticipated letters of intent.

Letters of Intent



- Project name, location and submission date
- Site work completed and future work planned
- Signed by corporate officer
- Industry history ~34% submission rate in any given year
- Early and accurate letters of intent

Budget



- Based on letters of intent
- Formulation starts 2 years in advance
- Assumes the ~34% submission history
- Staff capacity 4 to 6 major licensing actions at any given time
- FY15 major licensing load all carryover except 1 renewal application
- Operating site inspections and amendments increasing

Section 106 Consultation



- Completed 4 Section 106 reviews since previous workshop
- 7 reviews currently under way
- Improvements
 - Proactive coordination with State Agencies and Advisory Council on Historic Preservation
 - Increased Tribal outreach
 - Earlier engagement of stakeholders
 - Using experts to support our review
 - Developing uranium recovery guidance
 - Open site approach

NMA Issues



- Fee Billing
 - Process on level of detail provided in May 29, 2014 letter
- Pre-licensing Construction
 - Need to understand concerns
- Structure and Focus of Reviews
 - April 2014 meeting
- Agency Resources
 - Efficiency in review process
- Guidance
 - Development schedule
- EPA Rulemakings
 - Subpart W draft rule out for comment
 - 40 CFR 192 in development, scope of conforming rule
- Section 106
 - Draft guidance, staff open to efficiency ideas

Hearings



- Five current reviews have a hearing component (Powertech, Strata, Crow Butte license renewal, Crow Butte North Trend, Crow Butte Marsland)
- Hearing activities on-going with one action (Powertech)
- Anticipate increased hearing related activities later this year
