

Please find attached for the United States Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) Staff's consideration a completed copy of NRC Form 313 requesting that NRC Staff change the name on NRC License No. SUA-1580 from the current licensee's name of Hydro Resources, Inc. (HRI) to NuFuels, Inc. By this letter, HRI's parent company, Laramide Resources, Ltd. (Laramide) certifies that it has investigated the availability of the corporate name NuFuels, Inc. and has determined that it is available for use within the scope of the laws of the State of Delaware where the licensee is currently incorporated. In addition, the corporate name NuFuels, Inc. has been reserved by Laramide for purposes of this request. HRI requests that NRC Staff formally approve this name change in writing prior to the filing of the appropriate forms and fees with the State of Delaware's Secretary of State's office so that the licensee's name may be changed effective upon formal approval from Delaware. HRI commits to submitting a copy of all approved forms and other correspondence to NRC Staff upon approval of the State and to make such approved forms available for inspection should the need arise. HRI also requests that NRC Staff notify HRI by electronic mail when approval has been granted so that the filing of the appropriate forms and fees with Delaware may be completed expeditiously.
