The purpose of this letter is to provide clarification regarding Enclosure 4 to the Niagara Mohawk Power Corporation letter dated July 22, 1993 (NMP2L 1397) to the NRC which submitted the General Electric Report of Reference 1. Enclosure 4 to the Niagara Mohawk letter contained the General Electric Affidavit of Reference 2.

As stated in the Reference 2 Affidavit "this document, taken as a whole, constitutes a proprietary compilation of information." Release to the public of the information in Section 11.4 of Reference 1 is not deemed competitively significant and appears necessary for NRC processing of the power uprate application. Therefore, consistent with the Affidavit, the "release" of Section 11.4 (Significant Hazards Consideration Assessment) for NRC use in processing the 10CFR50.92 application or in preparation of the SER for Nine Mile Point 2 power uprate of the Reference 1 power uprate report is acceptable to General Electric Company.
