Pursuant to section 51.29 of title 10 of the *Code* of *Federal Regulations* (10 CFR), the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff conducted the environmental scoping process and solicited public comments from February 18, 2022, to April 19, 2022 (87 FR 9394). This process informed the scope of the staff's environmental review of the application for a construction permit submitted by Kairos for a test reactor termed Hermes. The scoping process is an important step in the development of the draft EIS.

As part of the scoping process, the staff held a public environmental scoping meeting via webinar on March 23, 2021, to solicit public input regarding the scope of the environmental review.
