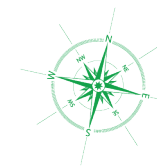


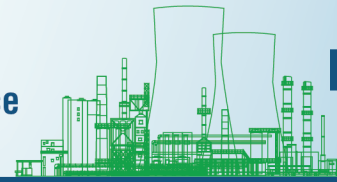
Key Messages

Provide perspectives on the future of planned activities related to risk informed research, guidance, and tools to continue improving the regulatory process

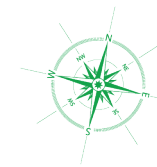


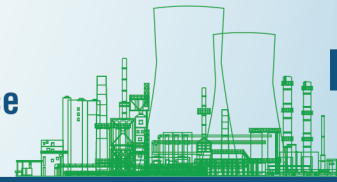
