Effective October 1, 2024

**PAPER METHODS OF PAYMENT, INCLUDING CHECKS,
WILL NO LONGER BE ACCEPTED.**

WHAT IS THE PAPERLESS PAYMENT METHOD INITIATIVE?

To comply with a U.S. Department of the Treasury mandate, the NRC Fiscal Year 2024 Fee Policy states that the Paperless Payment Methods initiative will go into effect on **October 1, 2024**.

The NRC lockbox will **stop accepting paper payments**, such as checks.

ACCEPTED PAYMENT METHODS

EFFECTIVE OCTOBER 1, 2024, THE NRC WILL ONLY ACCEPT ELECTRONIC PAYMENT METHODS.


- Pay.gov offers licensees and customers four electronic payment options:
 - Amazon account
 - Bank account
 - Debit or credit card
 - PayPal account
- For international payments, licensees and customers can use FedWire or PayPal

WHAT ARE THE BENEFITS?

- Improve timeliness of payment submission to the NRC
- Speed up payment processing and thereby reduce interest, penalty, and administrative fees associated with late payments
- Enhance processing speed, efficiency, and accuracy by using available electronic payment options
- Eliminate resources needed for processing paper payments
- Reduce the time and cost for stakeholders, taxpayers, and the NRC

HOW TO MAKE ELECTRONIC PAYMENTS THROUGH PAY.GOV?

1. Navigate to the Pay.gov website
2. Select See All Agencies


